



## « Wonderful Swifts » :

### Details of a drawing competition

Organised by  
Swifts Without Frontiers

#### Article 1

Swifts Without Frontiers (SWF) are organising, for World Swift Day, a drawing competition entitled “Wonderful Swifts”, from the 1<sup>st</sup> to the 31<sup>st</sup> of May 2020, inclusive, 18h (Central European Summer Time).

#### Article 2

The competition is open to all – adults & children above 3 years old.

Children’s entries are divided into the following 5 categories:

- Category 1 : 3-5 years old
- Category 2 : 6-8 years old
- Category 3 : 9-12 years old
- Category 4 : 13-17 years old
- Category 5 : 18 years old and over

Participation is free & it is not necessary to be a member of the association.

### Article 3

Entries can represent any species of swift.

The characteristics, habitats & the threats posed to these birds can be illustrated.

It is suggested that the pictures are done in horizontal format, size A4.

All art materials can be used (eg crayon, felt pen or paint) but the result must be a flat image - not a collage, for example. It does not need to be done on paper but you can use your ipad or other tablet or computer device as long as you create something original; it must be all your own work.

« #worldswiftday » must be written on the bottom right hand corner of the picture.

As this competition is international it is recommended to not include a text.

### Article 4

To take part:

1 Draw a picture with the theme “Wonderful Swifts”

2- You can send your art work to Swifts Without Frontiers from 6 p.m. (Brussels time) on 4th May until midnight on 31st May 2020. Your entry must comply with the following instructions:

- Accepted file format is jpeg (preferably), png or pdf.
- High definition image for A4 printing: minimum 1600px for the long side.
- Send the file by [wetransfer.com](https://wetransfer.com) addressed to **contact@worldswiftday.org**. Please note that direct sending of files to this address will not be accepted.
- In the accompanying message, specify your:
  - name
  - first name
  - age
  - city/town/village and country; and
  - email address.

## **Article 5**

The jury will be made up of people independent of the association, including:

- Professors or teachers
- Artists
- Representatives of organizations involved in the protection of swifts.

## **Article 6**

For each of the five categories, the jury will pre-select 10 drawings, based on their artistic quality and their relevance to the theme.

On June 7, the 50 preselected drawings will be submitted to a public vote for a "special public prize".

The jury will then elect, for each category, the two winning designs.

The members of the jury will independently judge each of the 50 drawings selected by assigning them a score from 0 to 10 according to the following criteria:

- Relevance to the theme, scored from 0 to 5
- Artistic quality, scored from 0 to 5

The winning designs will be those that have obtained the highest marks within their category. In the event of a tie, the jury will deliberate to decide between the winners.

## **Article 7**

No prize will be awarded.

The winning drawings will be published on the World Swift Day website ([www.worldswiftday.org](http://www.worldswiftday.org)) and on the Facebook page of SWF (<https://www.facebook.com/martinetssansfrontieres>).

## **Article 8**

Winners will be notified individually.

If participation in the competition has been organised by a school or an association, the participating organisation will also be notified.

The names of the winners will then be posted on the World Swift Day website, as well as on the Facebook page of Swifts Without Frontiers.

## **Article 9**

By participating in the contest, the participants authorise Swifts Without Frontiers to reproduce and use their drawings with their names, first names and age in Swifts Without Frontiers's own information activities in whatever medium (including their exhibition or publication), without conferring on the originator any right of remuneration.

By participating in this competition, the authors agree to assign all their rights to their art works to Swifts Without Frontiers. All the drawings entered in this competition will become the property of Swifts Without Frontiers.

**Article 10**

Personal data will not be passed on to third parties for commercial purposes.

**Article 11**

None of the costs incurred in participating in this competition will be borne by the organisers.

**Article 12**

By participating in this competition you agree to abide by these rules.

The decision of the jury is final and there is no appeal.

In the event of a dispute, the organisers remain the sole authority.
